Project Work Plan

Month 1-3 – Cohorts 1 and 2, Month 4-6 Cohorts 3 and 4

In the first week, the Project Coordinator will liaise with the Thumgomrey County High School to recruit participants for the financial literacy workshops. Junior and senior high school students will be invited to sign up for the after-school program on a first-come, first-serve basis. Two cohorts of 25 students each will be recruited for the initial three months program. The Project Coordinator will also liaise with local financial advisory companies to identify two financial literacy professionals to conduct the workshops. The Project Coordinator will work with the financial literacy professionals to come up with a curriculum. The Project Coordinator will also procure training supplies and snacks.

The workshops will begin in week 2 and take place for one hour two times a week for three months. Snacks will be provided at each workshop. The financial literacy workshops will take place at the Thumgomrey County High School.

At the end of the program, the Project Coordinator will distribute program evaluations to participants, have a debrief with the financial literacy instructors, and analyze feedback from participants and instructors.

In the last week of Month 3, the Project Coordinator will also work on setting up the second iteration of the program following the process outlined above. In Months 4-6, the second iteration of the program will take place for another two cohorts of 25 students each.
